- **POLISH-AMERICAN BOARD OF EDUCATION OF BERKS COUNTY**

Berks County seniors planning to attend college who have documented proof of at least 25% Polish heritage and have been residents of Berks County for at least four years prior to the date of application, are eligible for nine college scholarships totaling \$18,000. The deadline for applications is February 26, 2016.
