Today is Constitution Day, which commemorates the signing of the U.S. Constitution more than two hundred years ago on September 17, 1787. By the mid-19th century, many women were unhappy with the very limited rights given to them in the Constitution, and a 70 year long suffrage took place to achieve what many Americans at that time considered a “radical change.” In 1920, the 19th Amendment was passed to allow all women the equal right to vote, however, few of the original supporters lived to see the final victory. This past August marked the 95th anniversary of this victory, and a display outside the library has been created to honor this historical date. Feel free to stop by and learn more about the creation of the 19th Amendment, Women’s Suffrage movement both nationally and internationally, and the gender inequality that still exists in the United States even now, in 2015.
