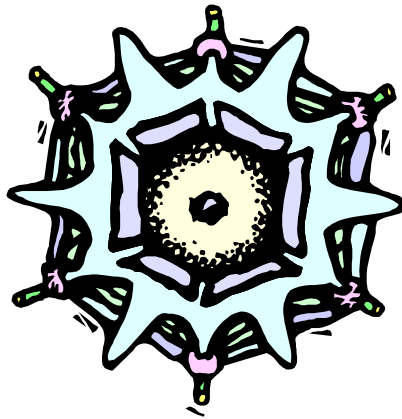
Holiday Party:
