## THE BOARD OF SCHOOL DIRECTORS...

### **Ratified and/or approved**

- general account bills in the amount of \$3,142,430.70 (6/14); \$92,660.85 (7/14); cafeteria account bills in the amount of \$75,591.00 (6/14); \$887.50 (7/14).

### the following from the Budget and Finance Committee

- a four-year lease agreement with F.N.B. Commercial Leasing (Pittston) for the lease of 231 computers at an annual cost of \$30,334.68.
